The Hobart Rugby Festival, is a festival of rugby held at The University of Tasmania (UTAS), situated in the beautiful suburb of Sandy Bay, in Hobart, Tasmania. Sandy Bay lies on the boarder of the Hobart CBD, the edge of the Derwent River, and at the foot of Mount Wellington. The festival aims to bring people together from all over the globe that love “the game they play in heaven”, and want to play, learn and celebrate this wonderful game together.

The Hobart Rugby Festival is a 7-a-side rugby festival for u16 rugby players held on the Saturday 13th April 2019. Teams will play between 4 - 5 games depending on the number of teams involved. All games are played on the same field at The University of Tasmania.

Teams will have the option of staying on for a few days after the festival to explore Hobart and participate in sightseeing and excursions.



Accommodation:

Teams will have the option of being accommodated at either The Hutchins School Boarding House or Wrest Point. Both of these venues are situated in Sandy Bay, close to shops, restaurants, public transport, and conveniently located less than 500m from The University of Tasmania. The Hutchins School boarding house can only accommodate 4 teams, therefore, teams wanting to stay at The Hutchins School boarding house will have to register and confirm their attendance. Once The Hutchins School boarding house is full, remaining teams will have to be accommodated at Wrest Point.

The Hutchins School Boarding House

The Hutchins School Boarding House accommodation includes the use of facilities such as an indoor basketball court, table tennis, pool table and washing machine.

- All accommodation is twin share.
- Staff will be responsible for supervising and monitoring all of their players.

Meals:

- All touring members will have breakfast & dinner daily in the boarding house dining room.
- Lunches will vary depending on the activity for the day.
- On game days, touring members will be given a coupon which they can use to receive food and a drink at the bbq/canteen area.
- On days where touring members are out on an excursion, either a packed lunch will be provided or they will receive lunch at the venue.

Wrest Point

Wrest Point accommodation includes the use of facilities such as an indoor pool, gym and coin operated laundry.

- All accommodation is twin share.
- Staff will be responsible for supervising and monitoring all of their players.

There are three different accommodation options available at Wrest Point, varying from 3.5 Star to 4.5 Star. Prices will vary according to the chosen option.

- Wrest Point Tower – 4.5 Star
- Wrest Point Waters Edge – 4 Star
- Wrest Point Motor Inn – 3.5 Star

Meals:

- All touring members will have a buffet breakfast & buffet dinner daily.
- Lunches will vary depending on the activity for the day.
- On game days, touring members will be given a coupon which they can use to receive food and a drink at the bbq/canteen area.
- On days where touring members are out on an excursion, either a packed lunch will be provided or they will receive lunch at the venue.
